



City Championship Tournament and Knickerbocker-Masters Tournaments

Tie Game Procedures

All FIFA Laws along with AYSO and Region modifications will apply to post-season playoffs and tournament play. If there is not a winner at the end of regulation time the following procedures apply.

Conduct a Penalty Kick Shoot-out (Refer to FIFA book). **Note that in this case ALL players at the game are eligible to participate.**

- * Five players from each team are selected. (Goalkeepers are eligible to kick as well)
- * The referee shall select the goal where the shoot-out will be conducted
- * The referee shall determine who kicks first by a coin toss (**winner chooses**)
- * Teams will alternate kicks
- * If no winner is declared after each of the five players from each team have kicked - proceed with a second shoot-out
- * The coach from each team selects another five different players
- * Same rules as with previous shoot-out
- * A winner is declared when the opponent cannot answer the goal
- * If no winner is declared after the second shoot-out the coach may select another five players – starting with any five players (even those who already shot in the first two shoot-out.)
- * A winner is declared when the opponent cannot answer the goal

Important note for the Championship game of BOTH tournaments:

Prior to PK's conduct a 10-minute overtime period. The referee shall conduct a coin toss to determine which team will kick off. At approximately five minutes stop the game and switch sides. The other team will kick off. (**Note this is not a sudden death situation – the entire 10-minute overtime must be played.**)
